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Born in Sassari, Andrea Solinas is one of the rising stars of his generation. Finalist of the 4th BMI International Conducting Competition in Romania in July 2022 and winner of the Special Prize of the Bucharest Symphony Orchestra, Solinas graduated from his hometown Conservatory at the age of 21 with top marks and honours as a pianist and approached the study of conducting at the age of 22, simultaneously attending the composition course at the same institution. In 2012, he continued his training with a Master's degree at the Conservatorio 'Giuseppe Verdi' in Milan, under the guidance of Vittorio Parisi, graduating with top marks.

As a pianist, Solinas was admitted to the masterclasses of the Accademia di Musica di Pinerolo and the Scuola di Musica di Fiesole, continuing his studies under the guidance of great pianists such as Enrico Stellini, Pietro de Maria and Andrea Lucchesini, pursuing a solo career both in Italy and abroad.

Starting an intense collaboration with opera singers, Solinas has worked as a substitute maestro in theatres such as the Ente Concerti 'de Carolis' in Sassari, the Teatro Lirico 'Giuseppe Verdi' in Trieste, the Puccini Festival in Torre del Lago, and the Arena di Verona among the most important ones.

In 2014, Solinas made his debut conducting Mozart's Davide Penitente in Sassari, at the 'L. Canepa' Conservatory and the 'Santa Cecilia' Polyphonic Association in Sassari, where he was appointed Artistic Director between 2015-2017. Since then, the Maestro has collaborated with the orchestras of Teatro Lirico di Cagliari, the orchestra of the 'De Carolis' Concert Institution, the orchestra of the Milan Conservatory, the Benevento Philharmonic Orchestra, the orchestra of the Puccini Festival, the orchestra of the Serbian National Theatre the Vojvodina Symphony Orchestra, the Samsun Opera House Orchestra, the Antalia Opera House Orchestra, the Ankara Opera House Orchestra, the Bucharest Symphony Orchestra, the Basel Sinfonieorchester and the Hungarian State Opera Orchestra in Budapest.

In June 2017, he was entrusted with the role of Stage Music Director of the Puccini Festival in Torre del Lago and the Ente Concerti 'De Carolis' in Sassari.

In recent national symphonic opera seasons, he has been assistant to important conductors such as Bruno Nicoli, Francesco Ivan Ciampa, Jordi Bernacer, Riccardo Frizza and John Axelrod, and since 2018 he has been working alongside Maestro Gianluca Marcianò, creating a close collaboration at the Serbian National Theatre in Novi Sad: in the same theatre from June 2019 he will hold the role of guest conductor, debuting in operas such as Rigoletto, Faust, La Bohème, Madama Butterfly and Aida. In 2020 he toured China with the Orchestra of the Serbian National Opera House and in February of the same year he signed a one-year contract as conductor at the Samsun Opera House in Turkey. From 2021 he has a stable and continuous relationship as conductor at the prestigious Ankara Opera House, conducting titles such as Cavalleria Rusticana, I Pagliacci, Un ballo in maschera and Tosca. Recent engagements include Cavalleria rusticana, I Pagliacci and Tosca at the Ankara Opera House in October 2022, New Year's Eve Gala Concert with the CSO Presidential Symphony Orchestra in Ankara in November 2022, "Christmas Concert" with the Orchestra of the Sassari Opera House and L'Elisir d'amore at the Cagliari Opera House in December 2022, Symphony Concert with the Orchestra of the Cagliari Opera House and Turandot at the Presidential Concert Hall in Ankara in January 2023.
